“Thy Kingdom Come” 25th May – 4th June 10am-5pm

St Mary's is joining in with this national prayer initiative for the days from Ascension Day to Pentecost Sunday to pray for the renewing and empowering presence of the Holy Spirit to 'make Christ real in our midst'. 'Thy Kingdom Come' will give people time and space outside their normal worshipping patterns to come closer to God. In St. Mary's we are focusing on two initiatives:

The Lord's Prayer – prayer stations. There will be seven interactive prayer stations covering the Lord's Prayer where you can just sit and focus on one phrase at a time, or experience the suggested activity if it helps you to pray.

“Pray for Five” Commit yourself to praying for five friends or family that you would like to help know Jesus. Use a piece of leather provided and tie five knots in it to represent each of the five people you have committed to pray for. You could carry the knotted string in your pocket, tie it round your wrist or place it somewhere that you'll see it regularly. Use the knots to remind you to pray for each person on your list of five. There will be a card available with a prayer to help.
