The Church Building

Parts of the present building date from the 12th century, though a Saxon church existed here before this. Notice the rounded 12th century arches and the more pointed ones from the 13th. The main altar is now positioned at the west end of the church, in order to make the most of the light and space; the wooden stairs to the bell-tower make an interesting focal point.

The glassed-in Memorial Chapel houses the town's war memorial. Carved stone heads in the south aisle are said to represent the Abbot of Eynsham, a wool merchant and other citizens of Charlbury.
