The Wedding at Cana (John 2:1-11)

Jesus and His Disciples were among the guests enjoying a celebration of marriage, which at that time may have lasted several days. The wine flowed until it ran out – and then we are given a brief look at the interaction between Jesus and His mother. When Jesus didn't seem inclined to do something about the lack of wine she had pointed out, she then effectively puts Him on the spot by telling the servants to do whatever Jesus tells them to do. His mother, resolute in the knowledge this *was* His hour (re v.4). And so with just a few words Jesus performed His first miracle, turning not only *just* enough but well over a hundred gallons of water into good wine.

It must have been a life changing moment for His disciples as they witnessed Jesus' first miracle perfectly revealing His Glory; both fully human and Divine. No wonder their belief was strengthened!

As we journey with Christ alongside, may we immerse ourselves in the Word of God, ever grateful for His Mercy, Love and Faithfulness.
